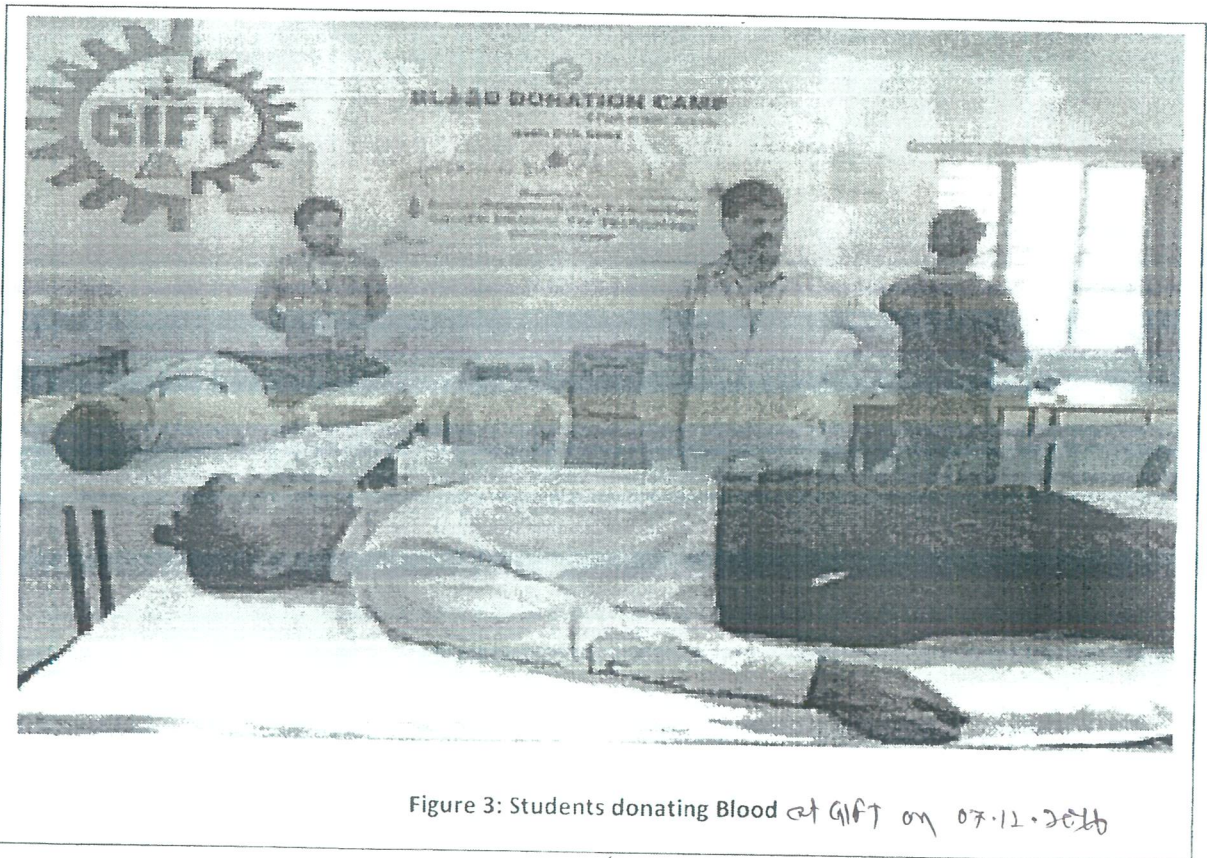
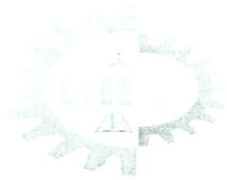


Figure 3: Students donating Blood at GIFT on 07.11.2026

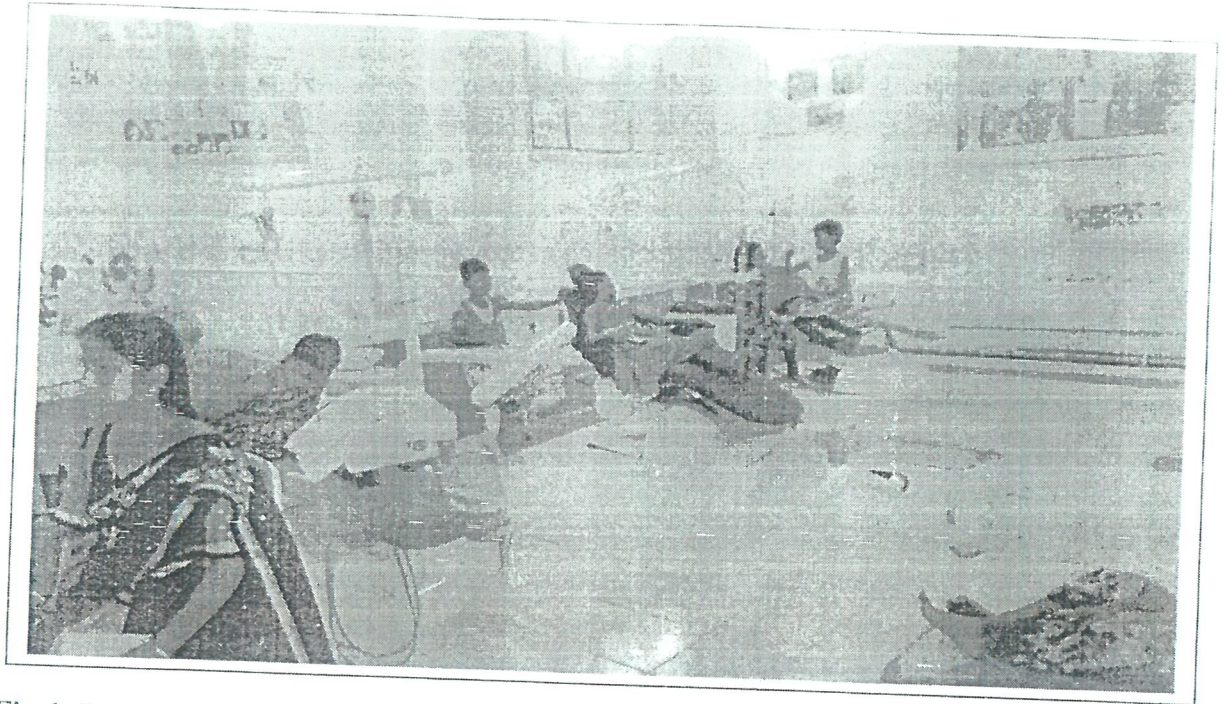
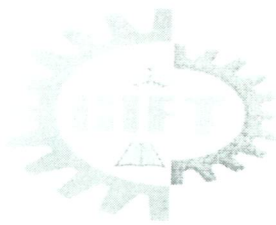


Fig 1: Dental check-up of Gramadiha village children at Hi-Tech Hospital

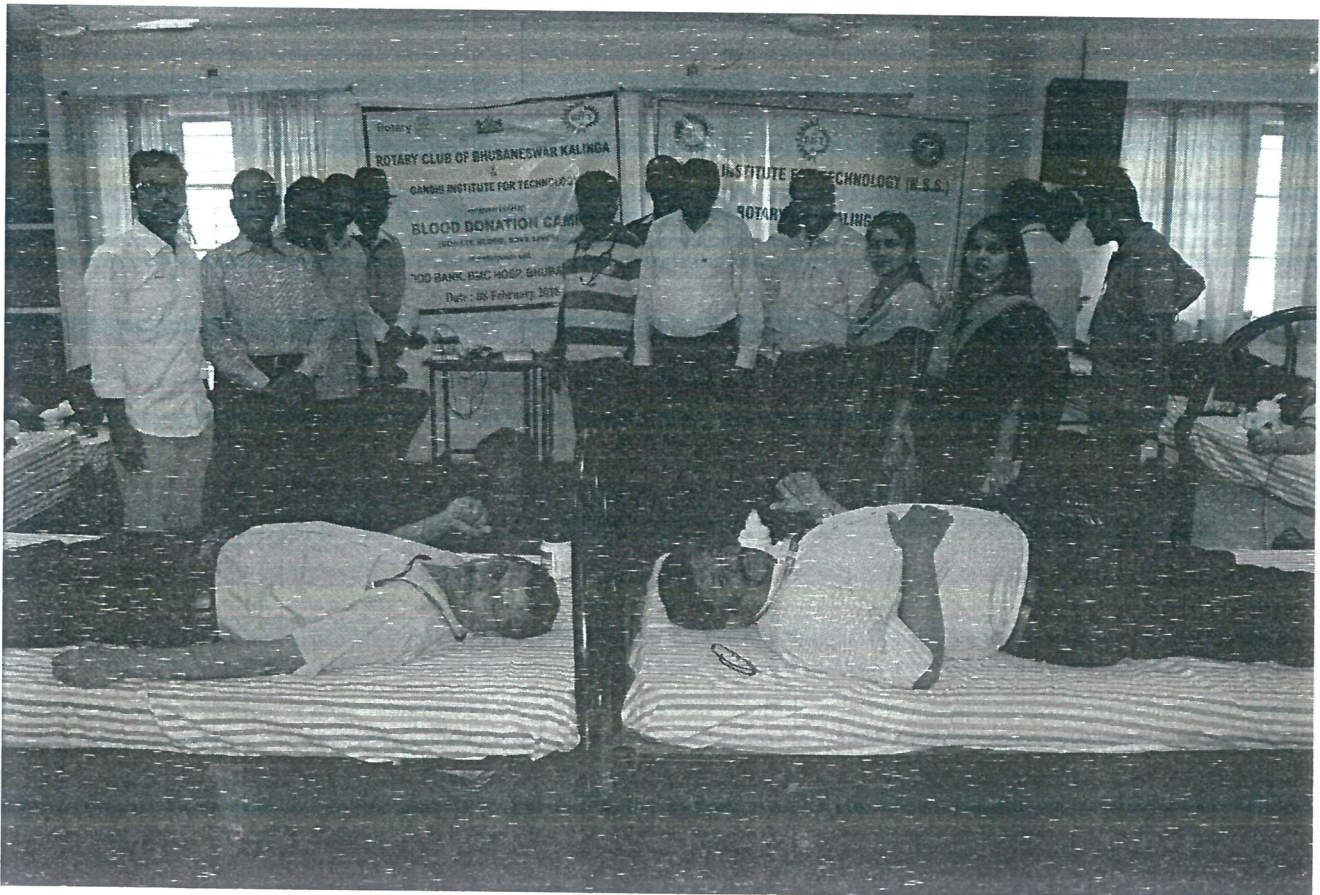


Figure 2: Blood Donation by the staffs of GIFT Camp at GIFT on 17.09.2017

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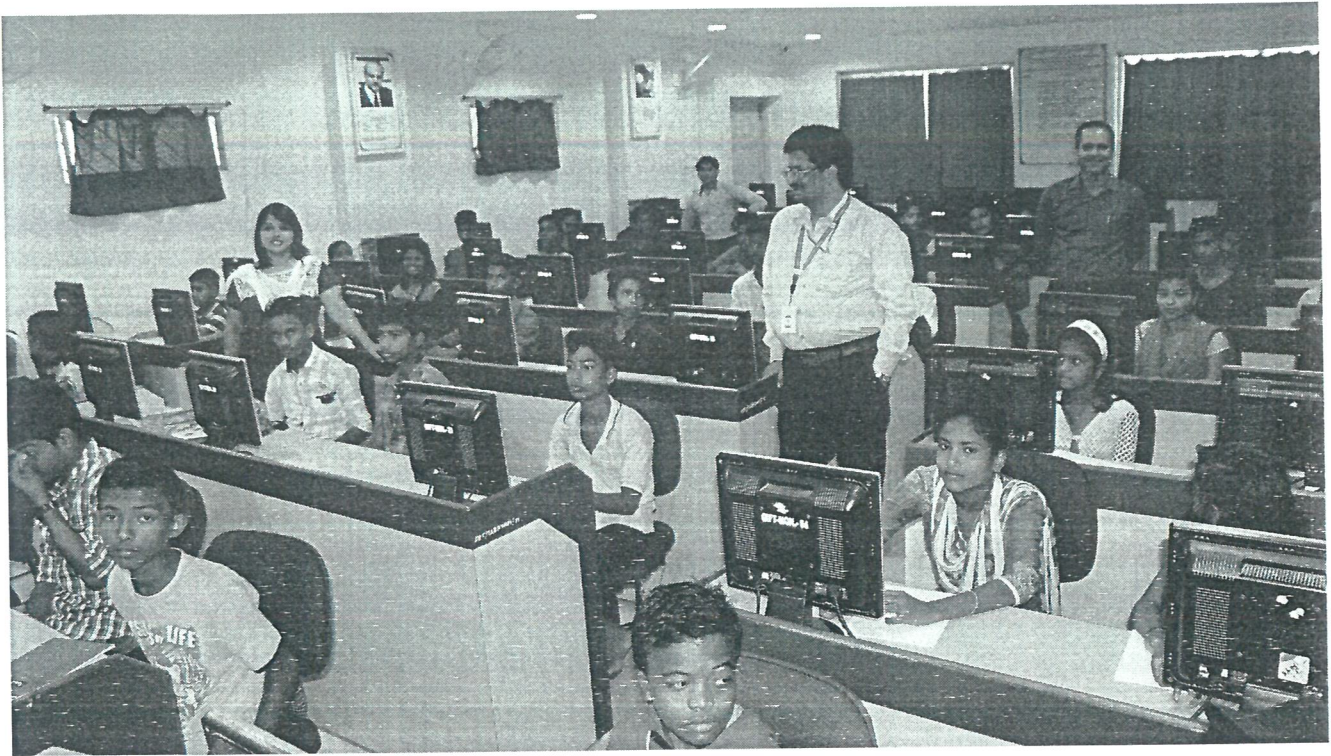



Figure 1: Computer literacy campaign at GIFT to the village kids on 22.09.2017

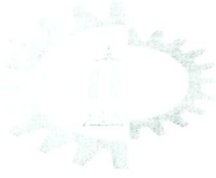

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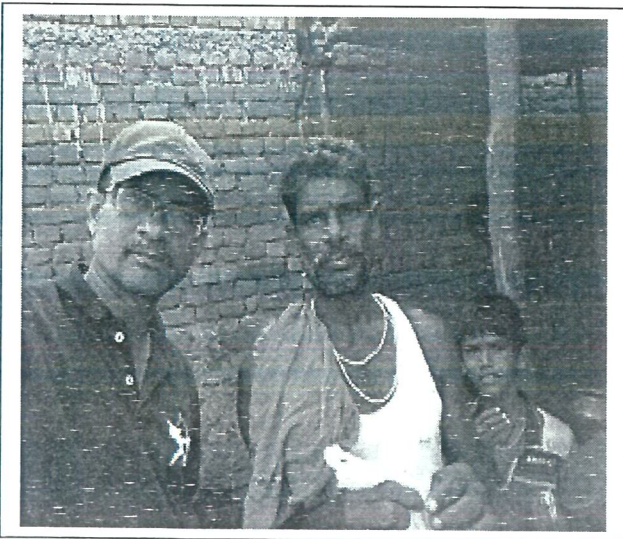
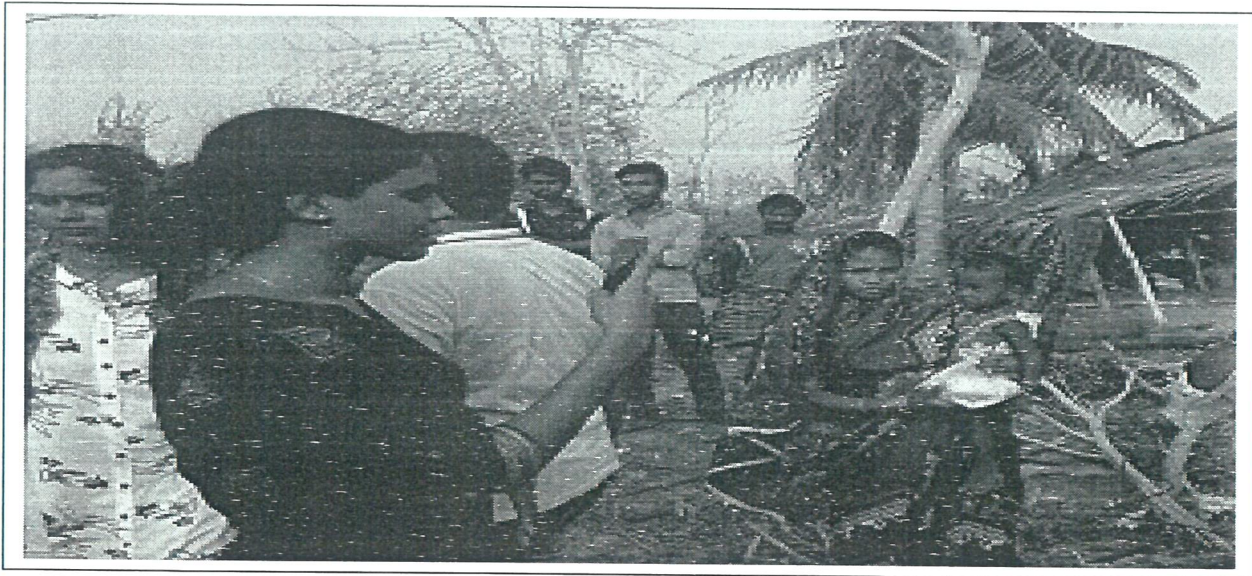



Fig 1: Visiting the FANI affected area and providing relief near Brahmagiri, Konark by the Giftians on 08.05.2019

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Fig 1: Obey traffic rules awareness program by GIFT in the village on 11.01.2018

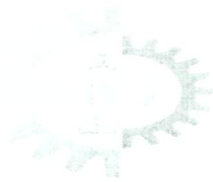



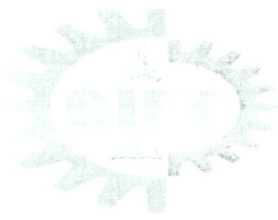


Fig-1. Students donating blood at GIFT on 27-09-2018



Indian Red Cross society National headquarters deployed the Assessment Team to the state of Odisha on 8th may for assessing the needs of the extremely severe cyclone Fani affected population

SITUATION REPORT

The extremely severe cyclonic storm FANI in the bay of Bengal had landfall on Odisha coast on 3rd May 2019 between Gopalpura and Chandbali around Puri district with the wind speed of 200kmph, storm surge of 1.5 meters with heavy to very heavy rainfall resulting in to extensive severe damage in 4 districts. A tentative figure of 18168 Number of Villages, 5, 08, 467 Houses, No. of destruction of electric infrastructure, 16.53 million people and so many are affected due to this heavy cyclonic storm.

Immediately during and just after the cyclone Govt has taken measures for the rescued as well as affected people where lots of social organisations took active participation voluntarily to render their best service and goods all possible types of help. The main issues are related to Health, Drinking water, Food etc. are there which much more important factors to be taken care are.

Also we have gathered lots of contribution from the giftians as well as personally in shape of material like food, clothes, medicines and money for the affected people.

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

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

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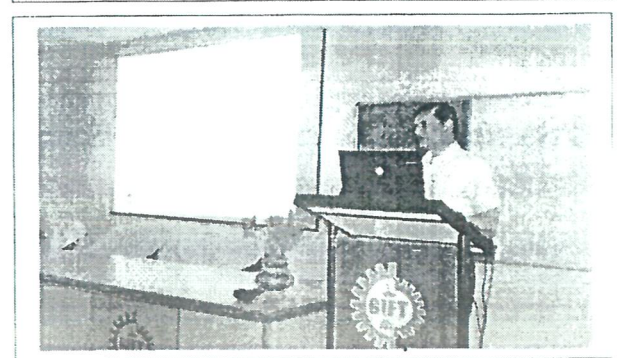


Fig 1: Visit to different villages to create awareness campaign on Jai Shakti Mission

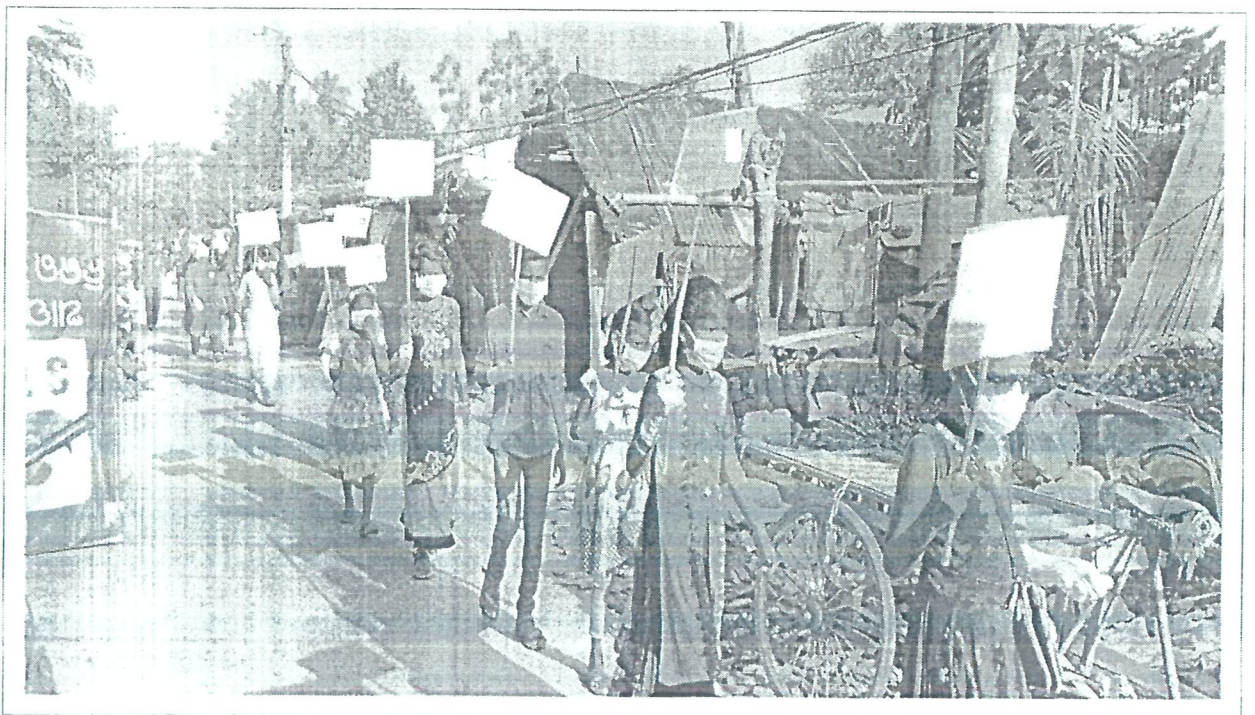



Fig 1: Creating awareness on avoiding polythene with the slum children , by Mr Gifkary

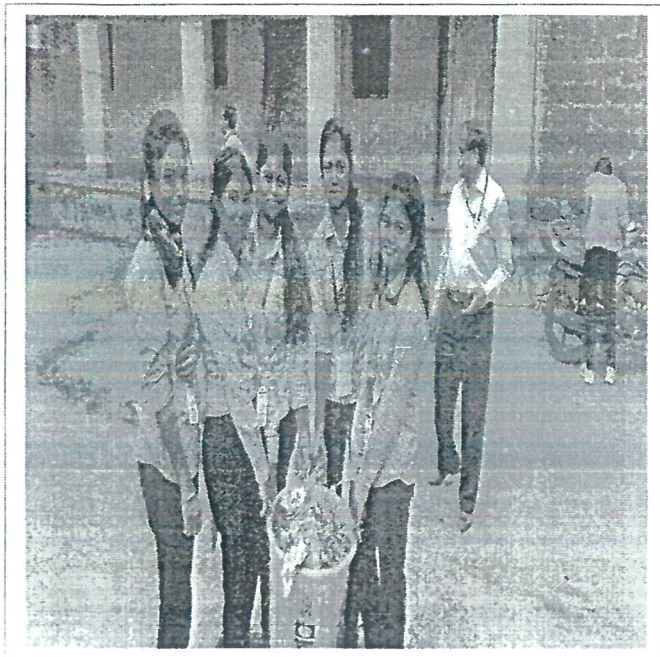


Fig 1: Visiting the nearby villages for cleaning and clean and green awareness in the Ek Bharat Sresth Bharat program by GIFT on 21.02.2020

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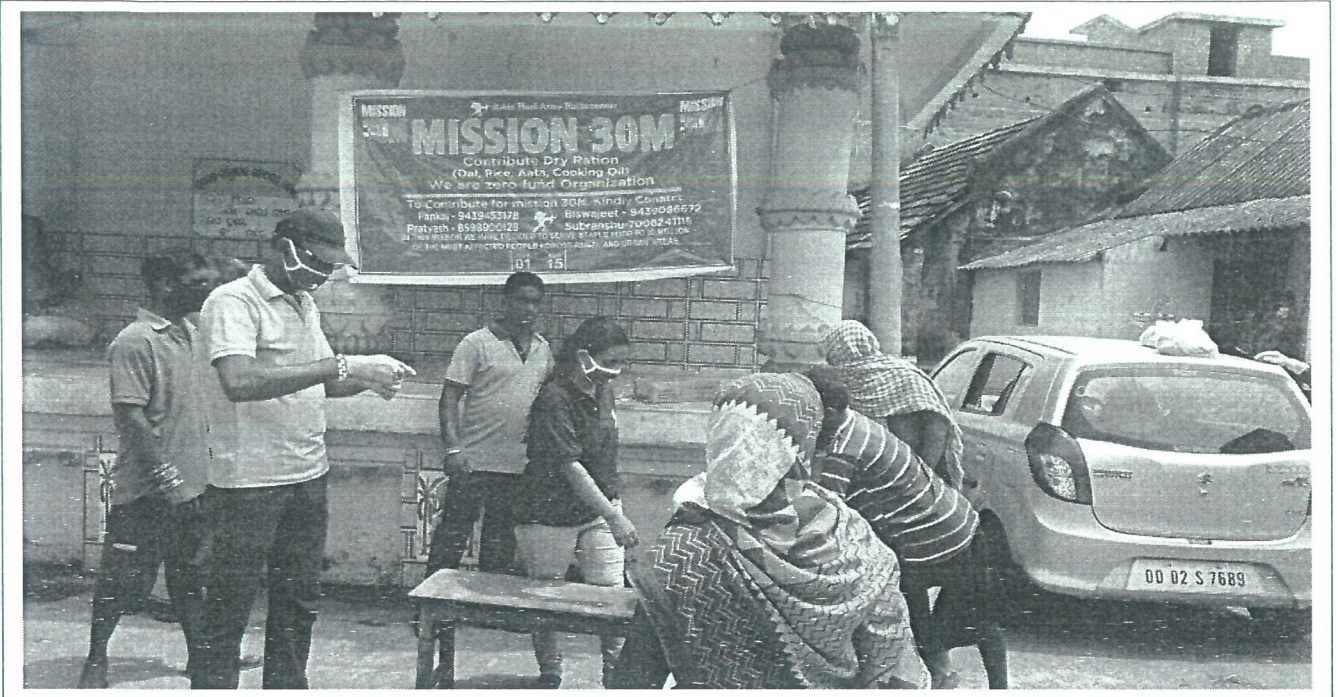


Fig 1: Distributing relief in Gramadiha village during COVID-19 pandemics by GIFT on 15.05.2020

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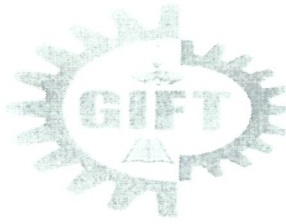

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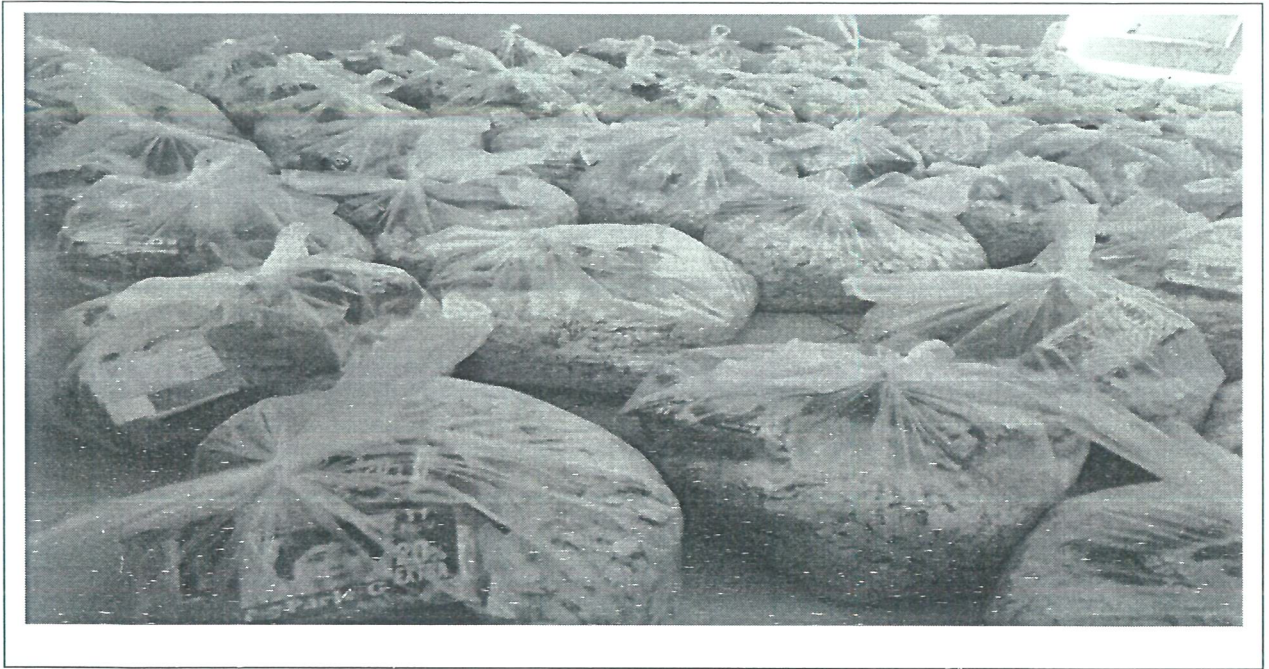



Fig 1. Relief material of to be distributed in the cyclone affected area durinmg AMPHAN by GIFT on 23.05.2020.


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

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Fig 1: Conducting COVID-19 awareness program in Gamei by GIFT on 16.05.2020

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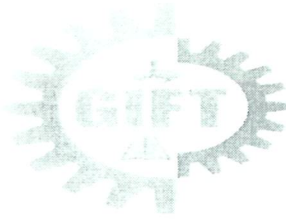

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Fig 1: Distributing relief in Bhatakudi village during COVID-19 pandemics organised by GIFT on 16.05.2020
